Do you need to take the SAT?

Students planning to study in the States are generally required complete SAT testing. The test is administered by the College Board. Canadian students are considered to be international students; therefore, your deadline to register for the December 4 test date is October 13, 2010. The deadline to register for the January 22 test date is December 1.

Although St. Lawrence is an authorized testing center, you must register online at www.collegeboard.com and pay your testing fees to the College Board. Study materials are available at your library. You
